However, before we do, I want to thank you for your support for our 2011/12 programme and particularly for the success of our Summer Recital on 12th June in St Bride's Fleet Street with mezzo-soprano **Máire Flavin** and pianist **Simon Lepper**. It was an outstanding success musically and socially with excellent feedback which was much appreciated by Máire and Simon and their friends.

Future Programme

Wednesday 3rd October is the date of our Annual General Meeting. The official Notice of this meeting, which will be in Europe House, Smith Square, London SW1P 3EU at 6pm, will be posted to paid-up members in the next few days.

As in previous years, we will have an event for our members and guests at 8pm to follow the AGM. This year it is something different. We are sharing it with a number of like-minded cultural organisations in the format of an "open house". This event will highlight our plans and those of other organisations which have the common aim of enhancing the cultural landscape in Britain, with a focus on Irish achievement. This initiative has the support of the Irish Embassy's Community and Cultural Affairs Officer, Jane Connolly, and the EU Cultural Attaché, Jeremy O'Sullivan. Tuesday 13th November will mark our first visit to the famous St George's Church, Hanover Square (otherwise known as Handel's Church) where Fiona Murphy (soprano), Owen Gilhooly (baritone) and Ciara Moroney (piano) will perform in concert at 7.30 pm. These three young artists are well-known to Irish Heritage and we can guarantee you an outstanding evening of lieder, opera and Irish tunes, together with a social evening and wine reception.
