We start 2017 with a "***Night at the Opera***" at the Princess Alexandra Hall of the Royal Over-Seas League, St James's, SW1A 1LR on **Wednesday 15th February at 7.30 pm**. It features the winner of the Royal Dublin Society (RDS) 2016 Music Bursary, **Aoife Gibney, soprano**, with **Killian Farrell, piano**, and special guest, **Carolyn Holt, mezzo- soprano**.

Aoife Gibney is the 2016 recipient of the €15,000 RDS Music Bursary. She recently completed her undergraduate studies in Dublin at the DIT Conservatory of Music and Drama where she was awarded a first-class honours degree and the Michael McNamara Gold Medal for Outstanding Performance. She is now continuing her vocal studies, a Masters in Opera, under Hedwig Fassbender at the Hochschule Fur Musik Und Theater in Frankfurt.

Killian Farrell, répétiteur and conductor, is a first-class honours graduate of Trinity College, Dublin, where he studied musicology. In 2012 he was the first conductor to be appointed to Opera Theatre Company's Young Associate Artist Programme. He is currently on the 2016/17 Young Artist Programme at the National Opera Studio, London.

Aoife and Killian will be joined by special guest, **Carolyn Holt** – mezzo soprano, winner of the inaugural Irish Heritage Bursary in 2015. Carolyn performed with Irish Heritage in September 2016 as part of her Bursary prize.

Their delightful programme will feature an array of opera arias including extracts from Balfe's *Bohemian Girl*, Puccini – *La Bohème*, and charming songs by Delibes, Rachmaninov and Gounod.

Caoimhe De Paor is an outstanding young Irish recorder player who has been based in London since finishing her studies at the Guildhall School of Music. She performed with Irish Heritage in October 2015.

Caoimhe has written to us to tell us that her early music group **Palisander** have been selected for the prestigious St John's Smith Square Young Artists' Scheme 2016-2017. This provides training in professional development, funding for a new commission and marketing project, outreach work opportunities and three performances at St John's. Palisander was described as 'outstanding' and 'thrilling', in reviews of the quartet's performance at Brighton Early Music Festival last autumn.
