**Have a fun night with Jazz at Kings Place
Wednesday 12th April 2017 at 7.30 pm**

Dear Friends, supporters and artists

Our next event is on Wednesday 12th April and is an opportunity for Irish Heritage to extend its boundaries in music and venues. It is not the first time Irish Heritage has presented a Jazz evening, but it is our first time in Kings Place, the most exciting and prestigious new music venue in London - and a notable Jazz venue. Our featured artists **Súp jazz trio** are an outstanding contemporary Irish jazz group who are rapidly developing an international reputation and it is a huge privilege for us to present **Súp** with a **London debut in Kings Place**. Súp trio is made up of leader, Cormac McCarthy (piano), Eoin Walsh (bass) and Davie Ryan (drums). All are graduates of CIT Cork School of Music where they had their classical training.

They will be playing a wide programme of tunes composed by Cormac McCarthy and arranged by the trio, with some jazz standards and Irish traditional melodies.

"We're all trained jazz musicians who have come through what could be described as the 'jazz route' but we all have interests in folk music and Irish traditional music" said Cormac McCarthy.

The trio represented Ireland at the 2016 Euroradio Jazz finals in Amsterdam having been chosen by **RTÉ lyric fm**. Following King's Place **Súp** will be playing at the *Cork Opera House* on 30th April 2017.
